1. How will Hudbay's planned groundwater pumping impact CWC's future water rates?
2. What recourse do CWC water customers have so they aren't forced to pay for Hudbay's massive water consumption through higher rates?
3. What steps is CWC taking to protect its customers from Hudbay's plans to pump more than 3.1 billion gallons a year when virtually none of the CAP water has been recharged in this area?
4. The CWC and Hudbay are business partners through a joint venture called Project Renew, which is a plan to bring CWC's allocation of 2,858-acre feet a year of CAP water to Sahuarita and Green Valley. Hudbay promised 10 years ago to pay for construction of a nine-mile pipeline and recharge ponds to bring CAP water to Sahuarita.

But a decade later, the project is only 20% complete.

6. What is CWC's long-term water supply plan if Project Renew is never completed and Hudbay constructs Copper World?
