- 2. What recourse do CWC water customers have so they aren't forced to pay for Hudbay's massive water consumption through higher rates?
- 3. What steps is CWC taking to protect its customers from Hudbay's plans to pump more than 3.1 billion gallons a year when virtually none of the CAP water has been recharged in this area?
- 4. The CWC and Hudbay are business partners though a joint venture called Project Renews, which is a plan to bring CWC's allocation of 2,858-acre feet a year of CAP water to Sahuarita and Green Valley. Hudbay promised 10 years ago to pay for construction of a nine-mile pipeline and recharge ponds to bring CAP water to Sahuarita.

But a decade later, the project is only 20% complete.
